

PayPal Send for Seats Sweepstakes – 2026 Football Season Official Rules

No purchase necessary to enter or win. A purchase or payment of any kind will not increase your chances of winning.

Participation is subject to these Official Rules and if entrant uses PayPal to enter, the terms and conditions of the [PayPal User Agreement](#). By participating in the Sweepstakes you agree to these Official Rules, which are a contract, so read them carefully before participating. Without limitation, this contract includes indemnities to PayPal, Inc. (the “Sponsor”) from you.

Eligibility:

PayPal Send for Seats Sweepstakes – 2026 Football Season (the “Sweepstakes”) is open only to legal residents of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia who are at least 18 years old at the time of entry. Legal residents of Florida and New York are each eligible for a separate prize drawing; 1 for Florida residents or 1 for New York residents. Legal residents of the remaining 48 United States and the District of Columbia are eligible for the Grand Prize drawing. Winners will be required to provide tax information. To receive a prize valued at \$2,000 or more, entrant must be able to submit a valid IRS Form W-9. Employees of PayPal, Inc. (“Sponsor”), Merkle Inc. (“Administrator”), and their parent and affiliate companies as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) and household members of each such employee are not eligible. In addition, employees, officers, directors, agents and representatives of the NFL Enterprises LLC, The NFL Parties (defined as NFL Properties LLC, National Football League, its member professional football clubs, NFL Ventures, Inc., NFL Ventures, L.P., NFL Enterprises LLC, NFL International LLC, NFL Productions LLC, and each of their respective affiliates, owners, subsidiaries, shareholders, officers, directors, agents, representatives and employees, both individually and collectively) and each of their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies (hereafter collectively, “NFL Released Parties”), and each such individual’s immediate family members (mother, father, sister, brother, any child, husband, wife and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and those living in their same households, whether or not related, are not eligible to participate or win a prize.

Agreement to Official Rules; Entrants Will Be Disqualified for Violations:

Participation constitutes each entrant's full and unconditional agreement to these official rules ("Official Rules"). The Sweepstakes is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited. Sponsor's and Administrator's decisions are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all the requirements set forth herein.

In the event there is a discrepancy or inconsistency between any statements contained in any Sweepstakes-related materials and these Official Rules, these Official Rules shall prevail, govern and control.

Entrants may not attempt to obtain more than the permitted number of entries by any means, including but not limited to using multiple email addresses, identities, registrations, or PayPal accounts, or by using any third-party artificial intelligence sites/applications, or robotic, automated, or programmed methods. Entrants may not tamper with the entry process, the Promotion Site (as defined below), or any related website, or network; circumvent any security measures; act in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner; or take any other action that in any way undermines the operation of the Sweepstakes or otherwise violate these Official Rules. Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, disqualify any entrant who engages in such conduct and void all associated entries. Any attempt to deliberately undermine the Sweepstakes may violate criminal and civil law, and Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law. Sponsor's failure to enforce any provision of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

Sponsor/Administrator:

Timing:

The Sweepstakes begins on May 14, 2026 at 12:00 a.m. Eastern Time ("ET") and ends on May 28, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. ET (the "Promotion Period"). Sponsor's servers are the official time-keeping devices for the Sweepstakes.

How to Enter:

There are 2 ways to enter the Sweepstakes.

Entry Method 1 - Enter by Making a Qualified Transaction using PayPal:

Step 1: PayPal Account in Good Standing Required

To enter using Entry Method 1, you must have a personal PayPal account in good standing (a “Qualified PayPal Account”). If you do not have a PayPal account, you may create one at [PayPal.com](https://www.paypal.com) or through the PayPal App. **Account creation is subject to the [PayPal User Agreement](#) and requires connecting to your bank or providing debit or credit card information.**

Step 2: Register

During the Promotion Period, visit paypal.com/enterp2psweeps (“Promotion Site”) and follow the links and instructions to accurately complete and submit the registration form with your first and last name (initials are not sufficient), email address or phone number associated with your Qualified PayPal Account, your state of residence, and select from the drop down your preferred team for season tickets should you be a Sweepstakes winner. You must also agree to these Official Rules.

Step 3: Complete a Qualified Transaction

To earn an entry, use your Qualified PayPal Account to send **\$10 or more** to another person’s Qualified PayPal Account using any of the following methods:

- Sending funds directly to another person using the “Send” (in-app) or “Pay” (web) function;
- Contributing to another person’s pool using the “Pool Money” function; or
- Responding to a “Split a Bill” request.

Each of these is a “Qualified Transaction.” You will earn one entry for each Qualified Transaction completed during the Promotion Period, up to a maximum of 3 entries by any combination of entry methods as set forth in the Entry Limits section below.

Note: If you use your wireless mobile device to create a PayPal account or to enter, data rates may apply. Please consult your wireless-service provider regarding its pricing plans prior to creating your account or transferring money with your wireless mobile device.

Entry Method 2 – Enter Without Purchase or a PayPal Account:

Print your name, address, phone number, email address, and date of birth and your preferred team for season tickets should you be a Sweepstakes winner on a piece of paper and mail it in an envelope with proper postage to “PayPal Send for Seats Sweepstakes – 2026 Football Season,” c/o Merkle Inc., P.O. Box 5008, Department 869255, Kalamazoo, MI 49003-5008. **You must also write the prize you are entering for on the outside of your envelope: New York Resident Prize, Florida Resident Prize, or Grand Prize (for the remaining 48 states).** If your mail-in request is timely received, you will receive 1 entry into the Sweepstakes. **Limit:** 1 entry per

envelope. All mail-in entries must be sent/postmarked by May 26, 2026 and received by June 2, 2026. All entries become the exclusive property of Sponsor, and none will be acknowledged or returned. Proof of sending or submission will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by the Sponsor. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, illegible, misdirected or postage-due entries, which will be disqualified.

Entry Limits:

You may receive 3 entries during the Promotion Period by any combination of entry methods. Multiple entrants are not permitted to share the same email address or Qualified PayPal Account. In the event of a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, Sponsor and Administrator will rely on the information submitted by the entrant to register for this Sweepstakes and that contained in entrant's PayPal account profile (if applicable). If any additional information provided by entrant is inconsistent with the information provided at registration for this Sweepstakes or in their PayPal account profile, the Sponsor and/or Administrator may disqualify such entrant and such disqualification may result in the forfeiture of any prizes won. Sponsor, in its discretion, may require additional documentation from entrant to show proof of entrant's identity.

Prize Drawings and Winner Requirements:

Administrator is an independent organization whose decisions as to the selection of the potential winners are final and binding. Administrator will randomly select the potential Sweepstakes winners from all eligible entries received during the Promotion Period, on or around June 10, 2026 and will notify potential winners by email. Potential winners (or parent/legal guardian if winner is a minor in their state of residence) will be required to sign and return a Declaration of Compliance, Liability Waiver and where not prohibited a Publicity Release ("Declaration") and an IRS Form W-9 which must be received by Administrator within 5 days of the date notice or attempted notice is sent, in order to claim the prize. If a potential winner of any prize cannot be contacted, fails to sign and return the Declaration, the IRS Form W-9, or provide any other requested information within the required time period, or the prize is returned as undeliverable, the potential winner forfeits the prize. Receiving a prize is contingent upon compliance with these Official Rules. In the event that a potential winner is disqualified for any reason or forfeits the prize, Sponsor will award the applicable prize to an alternate winner by random drawing from among all remaining eligible entries. Only 3 alternate drawings will be held, after which the prize will remain un-awarded.

Prizes:

Quantity, Description and Approximate Retail Value ("ARV"):

- **30 Grand Prizes:** 2 tickets (for winner and winner's guest) to each home game of the NFL team of winner's choice for the 2026-2027 regular season only. Preseason, postseason and international regular season games excluded. ARV: ranges from \$5,000 to \$10,000.
- **1 Florida Resident Prize:** 2 tickets (for winner and winner's guest) to each home game of the NFL team of winner's choice for the 2026-2027 regular season only. Preseason, postseason and international regular season games excluded. ARV: \$5,000.
- **1 New York Resident Prize:** 2 tickets (for winner and winner's guest) to each home game of the NFL team of winner's choice for the 2026-2027 regular season only. Preseason, postseason and international regular season games excluded. ARV: \$5,000.

Total ARV:

The total ARV of all available prizes offered in the Sweepstakes to the 48 United States and District of Columbia is up to \$300,000.

The total ARV of all available prizes offered to residents of Florida is \$5,000.

The total ARV of all available prizes offered to residents of New York is \$5,000.

Odds of Winning:

The odds of winning a prize depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the Promotion Period.

Additional Prize Terms:

Prize is tickets only; travel and accommodations not included. Sponsor is not responsible if any game is delayed, postponed or cancelled for any reason and winner will not be reimbursed for tickets. Seating to be determined in the sole discretion of Sponsor. Seat locations may vary throughout the season. Tickets may be subject to standard rain-check policies and procedures. By accepting ticket prize, winner agrees to abide by any terms, conditions and restrictions provided by the ticket. The Sponsor is not responsible if winner does not use ticket on day of event. Prizes are non-transferable, and no substitution will be made except as provided in the Sponsor's sole discretion should the prize become unavailable. In this case, a prize of equal or greater value will be offered. Winners are responsible for all taxes and fees associated with prize receipt and/or use. Winners that receive total prizes from Sponsor equal to or greater than \$2,000 within the same calendar year will receive an IRS Form 1099-MISC reporting the actual value of the prizes received. ARVs are determined as of the time these Official Rules were published and the value of a prize may fluctuate. A winner is not entitled to any difference between the ARV and the actual value of the prize at the time the prize is awarded. Where applicable, prize style, size and all other details will be determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. All other costs and expenses associated with acceptance of the prize that are not expressly set forth herein shall be solely the winner's responsibility. Prizes are provided "as is" without warranty of any kind, either

express or implied, including but not limited to the implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose or non-infringement. Prizes will be fulfilled approximately 8-10 weeks after winner confirmation is complete. Limit of 1 prize per person.

Release:

By receipt of any prize, winners agree to release and hold harmless Sponsor, NFL Released Parties, Administrator and their respective subsidiaries, affiliates, suppliers, distributors, advertising and promotion agencies and prize suppliers and each of their respective parent companies and each such company's officers, directors, employees and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all actions, claims, injury, loss or damage arising in any manner, directly or indirectly, from participation in this Sweepstakes and/or acceptance, use, inability to use, misuse or redemption of a prize (including any injury or harm related thereto).

Entrants irrevocably waive all claims against the National Football League, its member professional football clubs, NFL Ventures, Inc., NFL Ventures, L.P., NFL Properties LLC, NFL Enterprises LLC and each of their respective subsidiaries, affiliates, shareholders, officers, directors, agents, representatives and employees (collectively, the "NFL Entities") and agrees that the NFL Entities will have no liability or responsibility for any claim arising in connection with participation in this Sweepstakes or the prizes awarded. The NFL Entities have not offered or sponsored this Sweepstakes in any way.

Publicity:

Except where prohibited, participation in the Sweepstakes constitutes each winner's consent and grant to Sponsor and its agents to use the following information about the winner (to the extent provided by winner as part of the entry or winner confirmation process): winner's name, city, state, likeness, photograph, Sweepstakes entry, social handle and photo, voice, opinions and/or prize information for promotional advertising or other purposes, in any media without further notice, review, approval, payment or other consideration. Sponsor is not obligated to use any of the above-mentioned information or content but may do so and may edit these materials at its sole discretion, without further obligation or compensation. Sponsor will not use any of the above mentioned information in a manner that is inconsistent with its Privacy Policy or applicable law.

General Conditions:

Sponsor's Right to Modify or Cancel:

Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Sweepstakes, including but not limited to fulfillment of the prize(s), where any of the following "Issues" occur:

- Fraud;

- Technical failures;
- Human error;
- Any other factor that impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Sweepstakes; or
- Any event or cause beyond Sponsor's control (e.g. events such as natural calamities, national emergencies, widespread illnesses, declarations of war, acts of God, acts of terrorism) that interferes with any aspect of the Sweepstakes, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion.

Where one or more of the above Issues occurs, Sponsor will make reasonable efforts to award all remaining Sweepstakes prizes by conducting a random drawing from among all eligible entries received up to the date of the Issue; and/or modify the prizes offered.

Sponsor's Right to Limit Prizes Awarded to the Number Stated in these Official Rules:

In no event will Sponsor be obligated to award more than the stated number of prizes set forth in these Official Rules. In the event that more winner notifications are distributed or more prizes are claimed, due to a printing, production, seeding, computer, or other error of any kind, than the stated number of prizes, Sponsor reserves the right to award only the stated number of prizes based on the winner selection process described in these Rules, or if necessary, through a random drawing from among those entrants who were notified, confirmed to be eligible and where applicable, took the required action(s) to claim the prize.

Limitations of the Scope of Responsibility:

The Released Parties are not responsible for:

- Any incorrect or inaccurate information either provided by entrants or caused by printing errors or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Sweepstakes;
- Technical failures of any kind, including but not limited to malfunctions, interruptions, or disconnections to the internet, social media platforms, in phone lines or network hardware or software;
- Unauthorized human intervention in any part of the Sweepstakes, including but not limited to the entry process;
- Technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Sweepstakes, including but not limited to the processing of entries;
- Late, lost, undeliverable, damaged or stolen mail; delayed or misdirected entries or failure to receive entries due to limitation of third-party social network platforms;
- Entries that are erroneously deleted, lost, destroyed, or corrupted. In this case, entrant's sole remedy is to take the required actions to receive another entry(s) in the Sweepstakes, if it is possible; or
- Any injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant's participation in the Sweepstakes or to the receipt, use, inability to use or misuse of any prize.

Agreement to Arbitrate:

Entrant agrees that any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Promotion or any prize awarded, including without limitation federal and state statutory claims, common law claims, and those based in contract, tort, fraud, misrepresentation or any other legal theory, shall be resolved exclusively through final and binding arbitration, rather than in court, except that the claimant may assert claims in small claims court, if the claims qualify and so long as the matter remains in such court and advances only on an individual (non-class, non-representative) basis. This Agreement to Arbitrate is intended to be broadly interpreted. The Federal Arbitration Act governs the interpretation and enforcement of this Agreement to Arbitrate.

Arbitration is more informal than a lawsuit in court. Arbitration uses a neutral arbitrator or arbitrators instead of a judge or jury, and court review of an arbitration award is very limited. However, the arbitrator can award the same damages and relief on an individual basis that a court can award to an individual. The arbitrator also must follow the terms of this agreement as a court would. All issues are for the arbitrator to decide, except that issues relating to arbitrability, the scope or enforceability of this Agreement to Arbitrate, or the interpretation of the **Prohibition of Class and Representative Actions and Non-Individualized Relief** as referenced in the PayPal User Agreement and as described in the section below, shall be for a court of competent jurisdiction to decide.

The arbitration will be conducted by the American Arbitration Association (referred to as the "AAA") under its rules and procedures, as modified by this Agreement to Arbitrate. The AAA's rules are available at www.adr.org. In the event that the AAA is unavailable to administer the arbitration, another administrator will be selected by the parties or by the court.

The arbitration shall be held in the county in which you reside or at another mutually agreed location. If the value of the relief sought is \$10,000 or less, either party may elect to have the arbitration conducted by telephone or based solely on written submissions, which election shall be binding on the parties subject to the discretion of the arbitrator to require an in-person hearing, if the circumstances warrant. In cases where an in-person hearing is held, either party may attend by telephone, unless the arbitrator requires otherwise.

The arbitrator will decide the substance of all claims in accordance with applicable law, including recognized principles of equity, and will honor all claims of privilege recognized by law. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding, and judgment on the award rendered by the arbitrator may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof.

Payment of all filing, administration, and arbitrator fees will be governed by the AAA's rules, unless otherwise stated in this Agreement to Arbitrate. If you are able to demonstrate that the costs of accessing arbitration will be prohibitive as compared to the costs of accessing a court for purposes of pursuing

litigation on an individual basis, Sponsor will pay as much of the filing, administration, and arbitrator fees as the arbitrator deems necessary to prevent the cost of accessing the arbitration from being prohibitive. In the event the arbitrator determines the claim(s) you assert in the arbitration to be frivolous, you agree to reimburse Sponsor for all fees associated with the arbitration paid by Sponsor on your behalf that you otherwise would be obligated to pay under the AAA's rules.

With the exception of any of the provisions in the **Prohibition of Class and Representative Actions and Non-Individualized Relief** as referenced in the PayPal User Agreement and as described in the section below, if a court decides that any part of this Agreement to Arbitrate is invalid or unenforceable, the other parts of this Agreement to Arbitrate shall still apply. If a court decides that any of the provisions in the **Prohibition of Class and Representative Actions and Non-Individualized Relief** as referenced in the PayPal User Agreement and as described in the section below is invalid or unenforceable because it would prevent the exercise of a non-waivable right to pursue public injunctive relief, then any dispute regarding the entitlement to such relief (and only that relief) must be severed from arbitration and may be litigated in court. All other disputes subject to arbitration under the terms of the Agreement to Arbitrate shall be arbitrated under its terms.

Prohibition of Class and Representative Actions and Non-Individualized Relief:

Entrant and Sponsor agree that each of us may bring claims against the other only on an individual basis and not as a plaintiff or class member in any purported class or representative action or proceeding. Unless both Entrant and Sponsor agree otherwise, the arbitrator may not consolidate or join more than one person's or party's claims and may not otherwise preside over any form of a consolidated, representative or class proceeding. Also, the arbitrator may award relief (including monetary, injunctive and declaratory relief) only in favor of the individual party seeking relief and only to the extent necessary to provide relief necessitated by that party's individual claim(s).

Limitation of Liability:

Entrant agrees that any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Promotion, but in no event attorneys' fees. Under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim, indirect, punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased.

Governing Law:

All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of the entrant and Sponsor in connection with the Promotion,

shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Delaware without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of the State of Delaware or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Delaware.

Severability:

If any provision of these Official Rules is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court or other tribunal of competent jurisdiction, that provision will be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law. Remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect. If any provision is determined to be overly broad, it will be limited and enforced to the extent allowed by applicable law.

Entrant's Personal Information:

Information collected from entrants is subject to [Sponsor's Privacy Policy](#).
