Contracting Parties.

The contracting party and data controller is PayPal (Europe) S.à r.l et Cie, S.C.A., 22-24 Boulevard Royal, L-2449 Luxembourg. ("PayPal").

Uninstall.

To uninstall this Application, please use the application manager provided with your device or otherwise consult your device manual.

Application Use.

You agree to abide by and comply with the PayPal User Agreement and Privacy Policy in using the application to charge PayPal users for any items purchased on your premises or sold by your business.
